Landowner Participation Agreement

The Coast Ridge Community Forest (CRCF) is submitting a fire prevention project for funding to CAL FIRE and the Sonoma County Vegetation Management Program.

Project Summary: The CRCF Fire Prevention Project is designed to reduce and modify vegetation along critical roads to provide better emergency responder access, evacuation routes, staging areas, and a location to reduce wildfire intensity and rate of spread. Proposed fuels treatments will be constructed along Fort Ross Road, Bohan Dillon Rd., Seaview Rd., Blue Jay Rd., and priority designated private ranch roads. Treatment distances will be variable, depending on slope and relative geography.

When completed the treated roads will become part of a shaded fuel break network comprising Muniz Ranches, Jenner Headlands Preserve, and Sonoma Land Trust's Little Black Mountain and Pole Mountain. The project area (Cazadero) is designated a High Fire Severity Zone in the CAL FIRE FRAP Map and is designated as a Community at Risk by the California State Forester.

If grant funding is awarded, the CRCF agrees to provide a list of services that will be conducted on my property before any work begins. These services will be performed in a way to ensure the sustainability of the forest resource such that current management options will continue to be possible in the future.

By agreeing to voluntarily participate in the CRCF Fire Prevention Project I understand that this would be a long-term commitment and I am willing to participate in community maintenance as needed.
